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Week 1

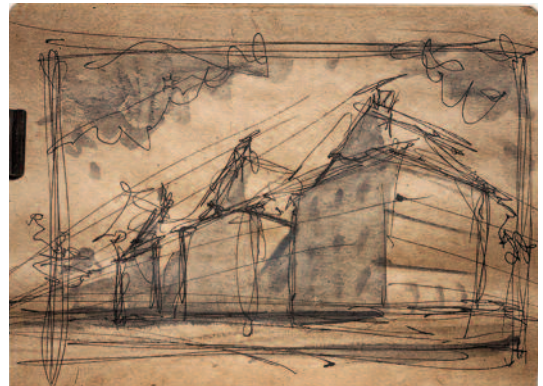
1. Take a photo of a building/house/structure that shows off 2-point perspective.



2. Create a thumbnail sketch

Using your own photo or my reference photo, do a quick thumbnail sketch. Use an ink pen and one tone for shading (graphite, pencil, gray paint).

Show the horizon line and perspective lines.



3. Do a watercolor painting of this same building.

If you're feeling ambitious go for it and do a full painting! We'll talk about color mixing, textures, and shadows in the weeks to come, so for now just play with some pigment and have fun.
